## **Registration:**

#### **Code of Conduct for Players:**

##### **You should:**

- help create and maintain an environment free of fear and harassment
- demonstrate fair play and apply golf’s standards both on and off the course

- treat others as you would wish to be treated yourself

- report behaviour that appears to fall below expected standards
- be organised and on time
- tell someone in authority if you are leaving a venue
- accept that these guidelines are in place for the well-being of all concerned
- treat organisers, federation representatives, volunteers with respect
- observe instructions of restrictions required by appropriate members of staff

**You should not** take part in any irresponsible, abusive, inappropriate or illegal behaviour, which includes:

- consuming alcohol or illegal or performance-enhancing drugs or stimulants
- using foul language
- using critical or disrespectful descriptions of others
